**Number Cards Write out the numbers 1 to 20 on a piece of card and cut out please.**

Please try to spend 5 minutes per day encouraging your child to read them and put them in order.

Choose 2 numbers: how fast can your child count forwards or backwards starting with one number and ending with the other number.

Can your child tell you the difference between 2 numbers? E.g. what is the difference between 10 and 8? The answer is 2.
